

Note: I recommend using Batik fabrics as they are more closely woven with 220 threads per inch which means they tend to fray considerably less and turn out to be a great choice for applique. (Try Batik.com)

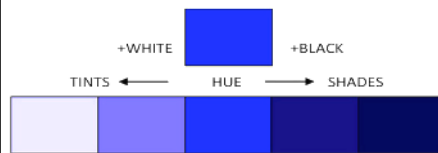
Quilt Top

Support Background - 1/2 Yard **black** Batik OR 100% Cotton with high thread count.

***For the project applique, you can bring fat quarters or scraps and do not need to cut these exact size pieces. These sizes are approximate.**

7 step Value Scale:
 DD – Darkest Dark
 D – Dark
 LD - Low Dark
 M – Medium
 LL - Low Light
 L – Light
 LL – High lights

5 Step Value Scale



Leaves- Varied shades of greens or your desired leaf color.	4-5 fat quarters total in a range of color values. -Varied shades of Light, Medium Light, Medium, Medium Dark and Dark Bring scraps if you desire.
Flower Petals -Varied shades of your flower petal colors.	4-5 fat quarters total in a range of color values. - 1 fat quarter, fat eighths or 1/8 yd pieces - in a range of color values. Bring scraps if you desire.
Flower Background 2 -FQ or ½ Yard	2 fat quarters of ½ yard Your choice of Blue, White, Yellow or whatever color you want in the background.

Other Supplies Needed

- 12" x 2 yards fusible web - Pellon EZ-Steam II Fusible EZ212 (*can use equivalent sheet packages – 2 packages of 10 sheets)
- 20" x 1 yd -Black Fusible stabilizer for appliques - SF-101 ShapeFlex /Fusible Woven Cotton – Black or White
- Black Thread for Quilting (Black 50 wt. or preferred weight)
- **Silk or** super fine 100 weight or Invisible thread - Clear and Smoke - to make applique stitches invisible
- Binding ¼ Yard
- Micro-Serrated Blade Scissors – 4" to 6" I like to have a couple sizes for use with varied sizes of pieces.
- Iron and Non-Stick Heat Pressing Sheet. Teflon Sheet
- Design Board - Recommend using Insulation board - size at least 20 X 28
- Batting - Recommend Quilters Dream = "Request" This is a very thin Cotton batting - size needed 20 X 28
- Pins for pinning your background and the vinyl to your design board. Optional - T-Pins are helpful.
- Stiletto – Sharp pointy tool for scratching off the paper and for holding things in place.
- Freezer Paper 18" wide - 56" total
- Borders and Binding as desired
- Freezer Paper -18" wide - 56" total
- Borders and Binding as desired

***Note - You may not get to the sewing. Dorene will demonstrate finishing.**
