## IRIS Pattern - Fabric Requirements

Note: I recommend using Batik fabrics as they are more closely woven with 220 threads per inch which means they tend to fray considerably less and turn out to be a great choice for applique. (Try Batik.com)

Support Background - 1/2 Yard black Batik OR 100\% Cotton with high thread count.

## Other Supplies Needed

- $12^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ yards fusible web - Pellon EZ-Steam II Fusible EZ212 (*can use equivalent sheet packages - 2 packages of 10 sheets)
- 20 " 1 yd -Black Fusible stabilizer for appliques - SF-101 ShapeFlex /Fusible Woven Cotton - Black or White
- Black Thread for Quilting (Black 50 wt . or preferred weight)
- Silk or super fine 100 weight or Invisible thread - Clear and Smoke - to make applique stitches invisible
- Binding $1 / 4$ Yard
- Micro-Serrated Blade Scissors - 4" to $6^{\prime \prime}$ l like to have a couple sizes for use with varied sizes of pieces.
- Iron and Non-Stick Heat Pressing Sheet. Teflon Sheet
- Design Board - Recommend using Insulation board - size at least $20 \times 28$
- Batting - Recommend Quilters Dream = "Request" This is a very thin Cotton batting - size needed $20 \times 28$
- Pins for pinning your background and the vinyl to your design board. Optional - T-Pins are helpful.
- Stiletto - Sharp pointy tool for scratching off the paper and for holding things in place.
- Freezer Paper 18 " wide - 56 " total
- Borders and Binding as desired
