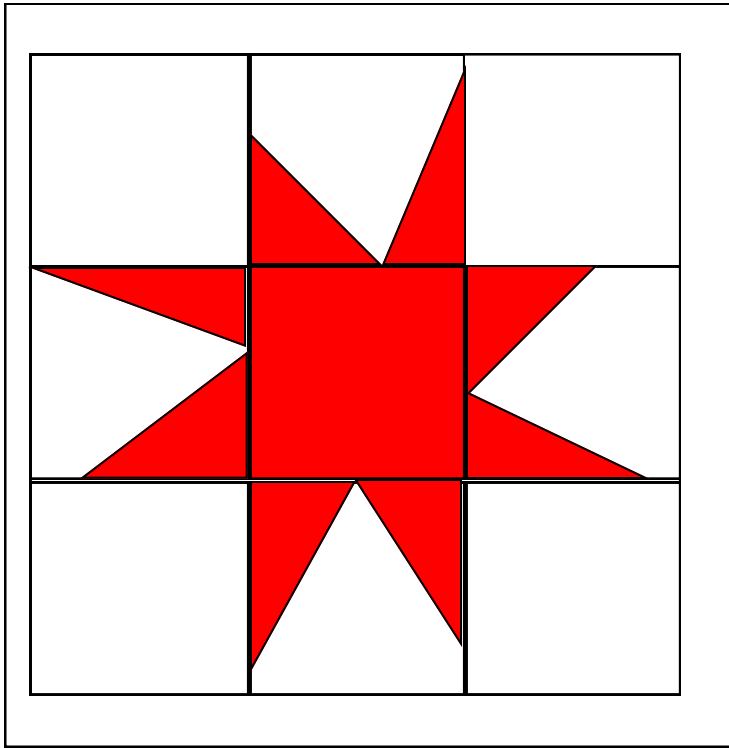


"Freedom Stars"

White on White and Red or Blue (Prints or Solids) NNMQG June 2015



A Patriotic Quilt in the making with the "wonky" star blocks just in time to have it ready for July 4th.

Guidelines: Blocks will be White on White, plus either red or blue (prints or solids) forming the "wonky stars"

- 9 1/2" unfinished blocks,
 - 9" finished

For each block cut:

A. from White on White cut:

(8) 3 1/2" squares

B. From Red or Blue cut:

(1) 3 1/2" square

(4) 4" squares

C. 4" Squares:

Cut diagonally to make
8 triangles

SEWING

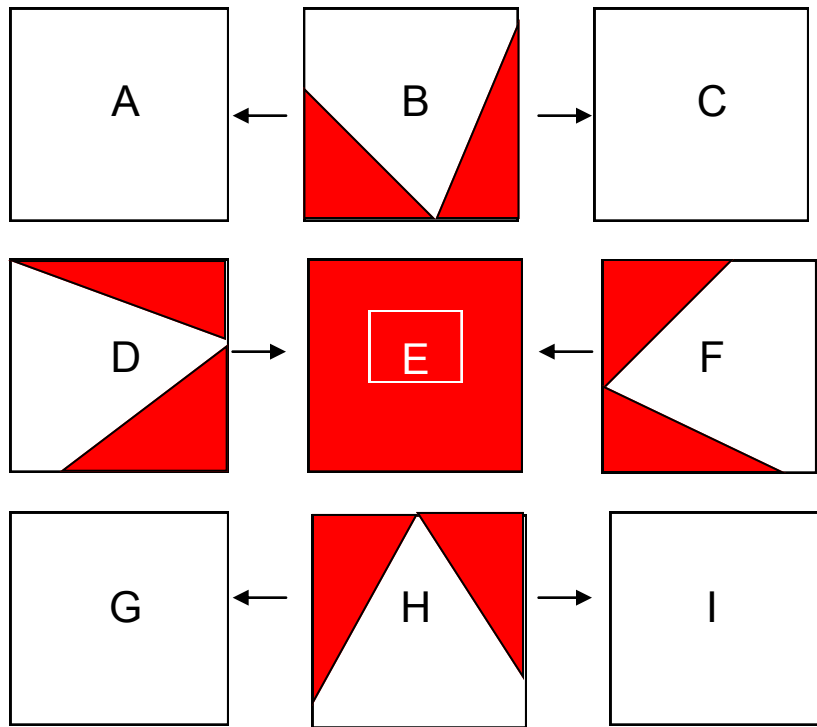
Sew blocks together with a scant quarter inch seam; sew using white thread.

- Using directions on page 3, make the wonky star points using one 3 1/2" white background and one 4" colored square cut diagonally for each of the 4 star blocks.
 - Following directions on page two, construct your wonky star blocks.

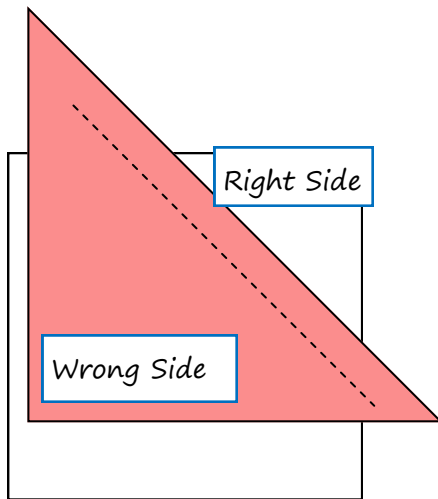
Bring your completed blocks to the June Meeting for the Block Drawing. You will get an entry for each block you turn in. Good Luck!

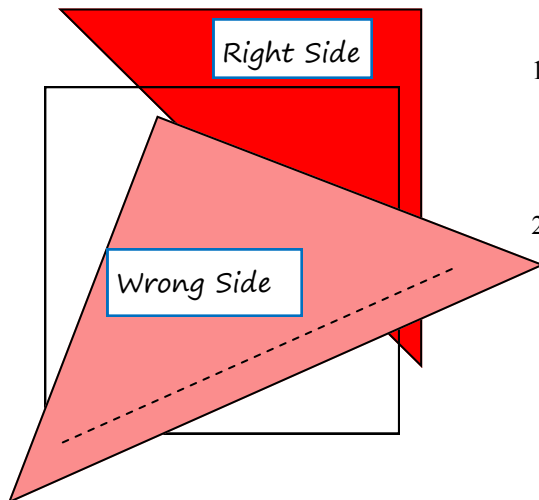
White on White and Red or Blue (Prints or Solids) NNMQG June 2015



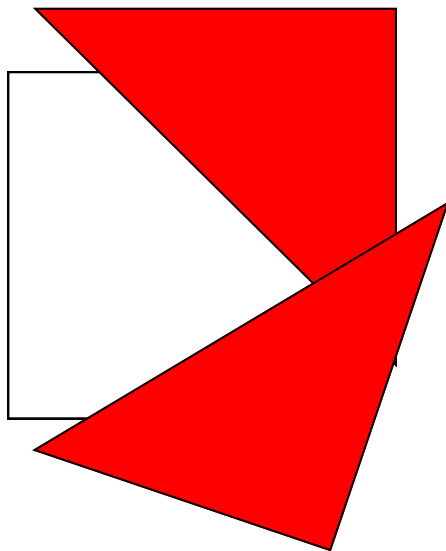
- 1 Make all Star points as shown on page 3, and arrange all pieces as above.
- 2 Sew A to B, and B to C. Press seams as shown by arrows.
- 3 Sew D to E, E to F. Press seams as shown by arrows.
- 4 Sew G to H, H to I, Press seams as shown by arrows.
- 5 Sew section ABC to DEF, Press seam down.
- 6 Sew section DEF to GHI, Press seam down.
- 7 Measure block to make sure it is $9\frac{1}{2}$ " square. If not adjust your seam allowance.



1. Place one colored triangle right side to right side on the white as shown at left. Stitch 1/4" from edge of colored triangle.
2. Press triangle to the corner.



1. Place second colored triangle right side to right side on the white as shown at left. Stitch 1/4" from edge of colored triangle.
2. Press triangle to the corner.



1. Trim block to 3 1/2", squaring with the white background.
