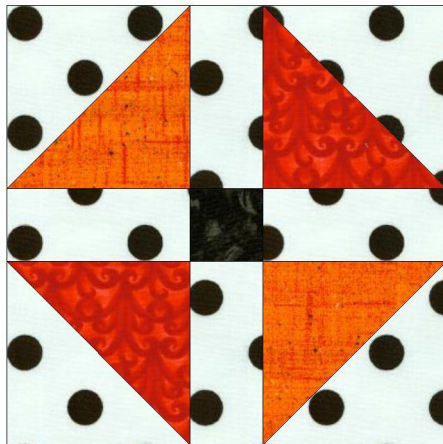


## **JULY 2015 "SHOO-FLY" NNMOG**

A classic and simple Shoo-Fly block to remind us of the hot, dog days of summertime!

(and those yukky fly specks!)



Block size= 6 1/2" Unfinished; 6" Finished

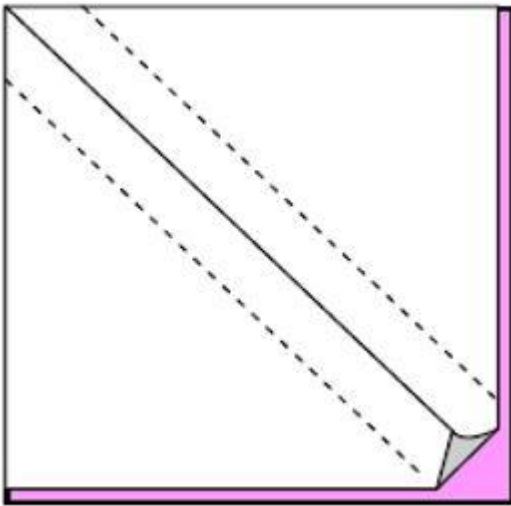
### **FABRICS:**

- Bright (HOT!) oranges and / or yellows
- Black dots on white for the background
- Black (or mostly Black print) for the center

### **CUTTING:**

- Orange/Yellow: Cut 2 @ 3 3/4" SQ (Can do 1 each of 2 fabrics)
- Dots: Cut 2 @ 3 3/4" SQ
  - Cut 4 @ 1 1/2" X 3"
- Black: Cut 1 @ 1 1/2" SQ

Use the 3 3/4" Squares to make 4 HST (Half Square Triangles) using the following instructions, when finished press toward the dark fabric and then square up to make 3" SQs:



Using the 3 3/4" squares: place one dot fabric and one orange/yellow fabric right sides together

Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner

Sew 1/4" Seam Allowance (SA) from the line

Press

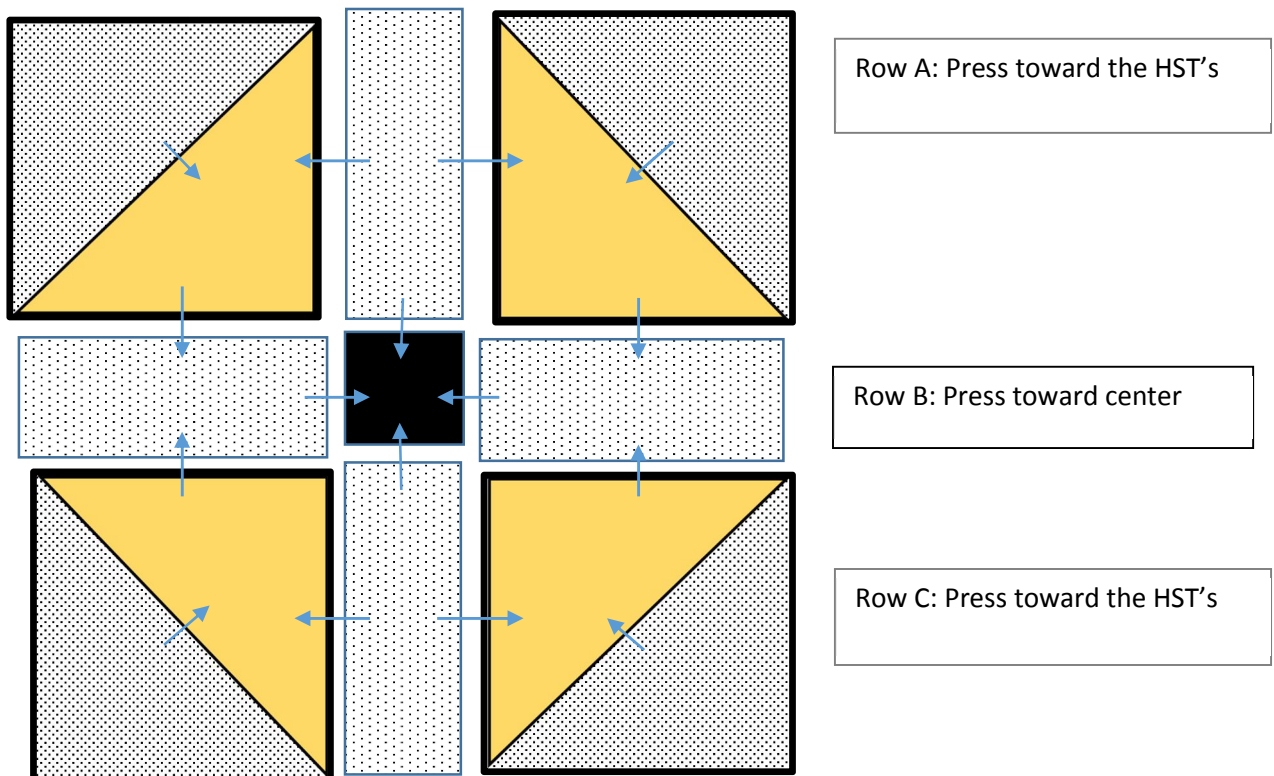
Cut apart on the drawn line and Press toward the darker fabric

Square up to a 3" square

Makes a total of 4 HST

SEWING: Use a scant 1/4" SA and follow the diagram for piecing the block:

Sew the rows A, B, and C



Connect the Rows and Press following the arrows on the diagram

Square up to 6 1/2"---

And you're done with your "Shoo-Fly!" Block!
