Big Stick Quilt Pattern



Baby Quilt - 4 by 4 blocks (44" square) Child's Quilt - 4 by 5 blocks (44" x 55") Chemo Quilt - 4 by 5 blocks (44" x 55") Adult Quilt - 5 by 6 blocks (55" x 66") Border is optional.

Cut 12.5" blocks*. Cut a 2" by 15" strip for each block.

Lay out your blocks and position one strip at a slight angle per block so you create a zigzag vertical line.

Slice the block and insert strip. All seams are 1/4". Press seams towards strip. We aren't looking to exactly match strip to strip, just suggest that the line travels up.



Do this for each block. Paying attention to the direction of the "stick. Trim each block to 11.5" or the largest measurement that works for all blocks. Sew blocks together.



* If you chose to use fabric with a pattern that has animals or objects that might seem distorted by adding the "stick", you may need to cut some of the block fabric out. That's what I had to do with my horses so their bodies didn't elongate.
